



## Post-Doctoral or Research Engineer Position in Logistics PORTERR project

### The position and its requirements

The Post-Doctoral/Research Engineer position has recently been funded by the Normandie Region through a project called "PORTERR". The project shall tackle the issue of efficiency of Norman ports. To do so, the way these ports and public/private stakeholders interact each other's in order to maintain a socio-economic development and a sustainable management of cargo shall be analysed. Additionally, the project aims at proposing a new approach to the decision makers in order to enhance the attractiveness of the Norman port system.

The PostDoc/Research Engineer will integrate the "Logistics Land Sea Risk" research area, within the "Métis Lab" and is expected to contribute to the deliverables of the project and to potential publications in high quality journals. He/she will be in charge of the following actions:

- Extract and model data from a GIS
- Design flows
- Follow the development of the project and ensure that the schedule is respected

The desired candidates should have the following abilities:

- A completed (or be close to completion of a) PhD in operations research, operations management, logistics, maritime economics, transport geography or a comparable discipline with a solid background on model-based research; master's degree trainings are also eligible in the selection process (research engineer);

- Autonomy and ability to work in a team,
- Experience in project management and ability to interact with professionals,
- Skills in Programming and in Engineering Software
- Excellent communication skills, orally and in writing in English.

- Contract start: as soon as possible for one year.
